

# iLearn Course Instruction Sheet for TABE 11 & 12 (for ICCB-funded programs) Course #2

Welcome to TABE 11 & 12 – Course #2. These instructions are for the TABE 11 & 12 (for ICCB-funded programs) Course #2 for TABE test administrators. Course #2 will take approximately 1.5 hours to complete. **Course 1 is the prerequisite for Course 2** – you must complete Part 1 before you can begin Part 2.

## **Quick Steps**

- If you are a **new user**, you will be required to Create a New Account (see pages 3-5)
- Click on **Assessment** and then **TABE 11 & 12 (for ICCB-funded programs) Course #2** (see page 6)

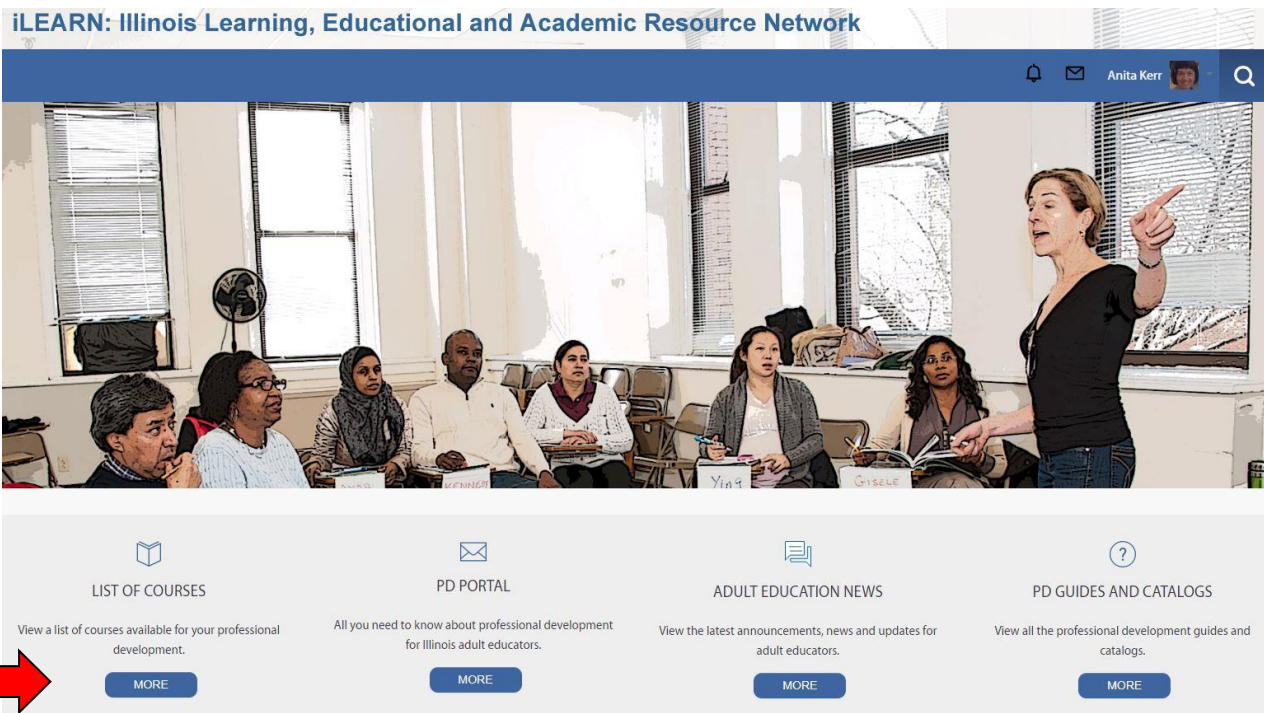

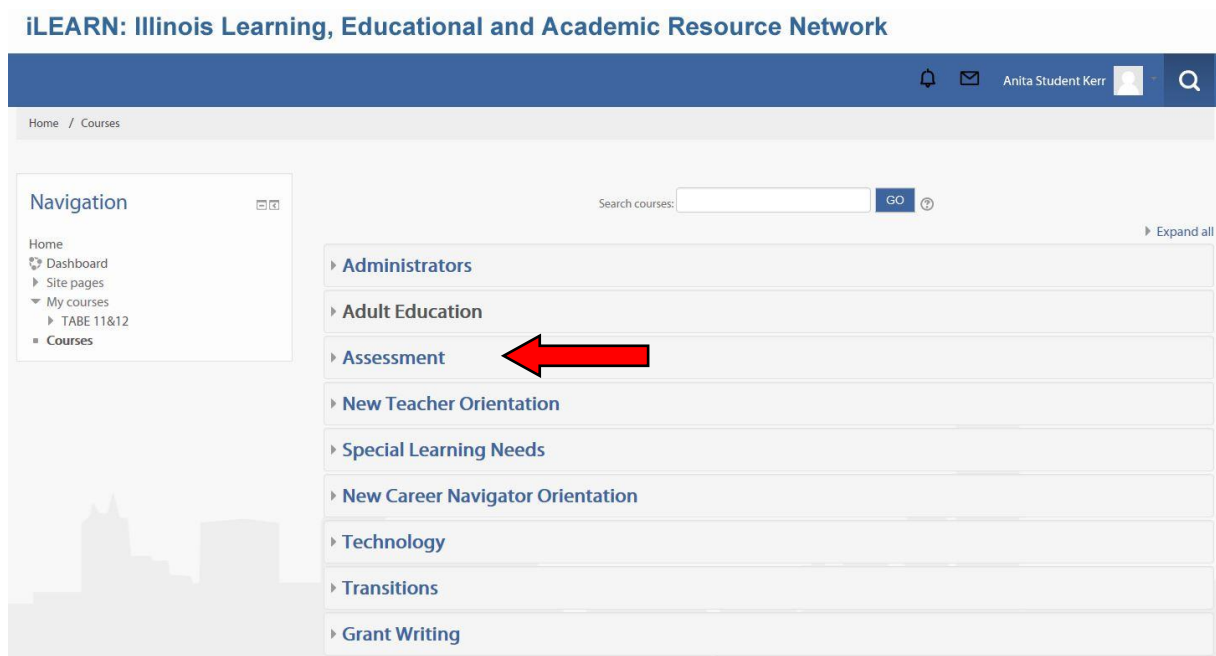


## Now – Let's Begin

**IL Remote Proctor Training for CASAS**
