

FY23 CASAS Training Information

The Illinois Professional Development Network (PDN) offers **two types** of virtual CASAS training, one for test administrators and one for teachers. Both use a **hybrid format**:

- Part 1: Complete free, self-directed online modules from the CASAS website
- Part 2: Attend a live webinar conducted by the PDN

TRAINING FOR TEST ADMINISTRATORS (Required)

CASAS Implementation Training is for those who administer paper or online CASAS tests: Reading GOALS, Math GOALS, or CASAS Life and Work Reading. It is required by ICCB for all individuals who give CASAS tests.

Goal: Participants learn to administer CASAS tests correctly to ensure validity and to maximize measurable skill gains.

NEW! TRAINING FOR TEACHERS (Recommended)

CASAS Tools for Teachers is for instructors whose students take CASAS assessments: Reading GOALS, Math GOALS, or CASAS Life and Work Reading. Separate trainings are offered for ABE/ASE and ESL instructors.

Goal: Instructors learn to use the CASAS blueprints and CASAS test reports to plan effective, standards-based instruction and maximize measurable skill gains.
