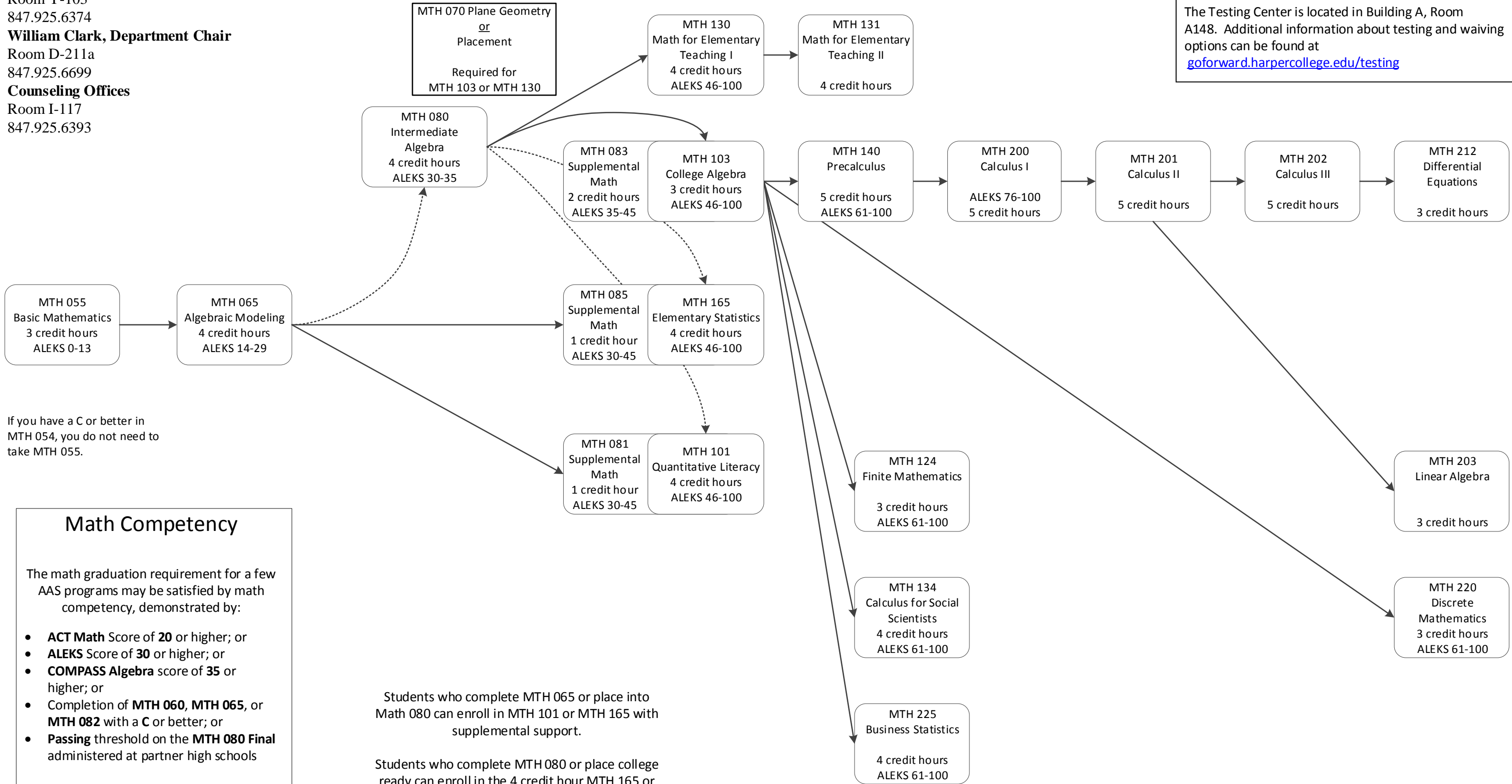

All students must either take a math assessment test or waive testing by submitting other relevant scores such as ACT, SAT, or AP scores prior to registering for their first math course.

If you have a C or better in MTH 054, you do not need to take MTH 055.

**Math Competency**

The math graduation requirement for a few AAS programs may be satisfied by math competency, demonstrated by:

- **ACT Math** Score of **20** or higher; or
- **ALEKS** Score of **30** or higher; or
- **COMPASS Algebra** score of **35** or higher; or
- Completion of **MTH 060, MTH 065, or MTH 082** with a **C** or better; or
- **Passing** threshold on the **MTH 080 Final** administered at partner high schools

Students who complete MTH 065 or place into Math 080 can enroll in MTH 101 or MTH 165 with supplemental support.

Students who complete MTH 080 or place college ready can enroll in the 4 credit hour MTH 165 or MTH 101, or the 3 credit MTH 103 without supplemental support.
