Question Addressed: Overall, how many of Illinois' residents aged 16 and older do Illinois community colleges serve through credit courses?

Source: Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) Centralized Data System--Annual Enrollment and Completion (A1) submissions and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.

Other Related Measures to Review:

Statewide Overview: In FY 2020, Illinois Community Colleges served 4.6 percent of Illinois' residents aged 16 and older through *credit* courses ($472,478/10,184,616 = 4.6$ percent).

Statewide Trends: Compared with FY 2016, Market Penetration for *credit* courses decreased 20.4 percent in FY 2020.
