FALL TO FALL ADJUSTED RETENTION

Metric: Illinois Community College Students Who Were Retained from Fall Semester to Fall Semester or Completed Programs.

Question Addressed: Overall, how many 1st time undergraduate students in the fall semester are retained in the following fall semester or complete programs?

Why Include This Metric? According to ACT, the national first to second year Retention Rate for full-time, first-time freshmen in public community colleges was 56.0 percent. ACT does not calculate an Adjusted Retention Rate at their website. The unadjusted overall statewide Retention Rate for Illinois – 58.0 percent – compares favorably with this national figure.

Other Related Measures to Review: Success in first-year college courses, Graduation rates, Transfer out to a four-year college or university.

Statewide Trends: More first-time students (+623; +3.3 percent) were retained or completed in the fall 2015/FY16 cohort (N = 19,690) than in the fall 2014/FY15 cohort (N = 19,067). Compared to the fall 2011/FY12 (N = 20,174), there was a 2.4 percent decrease (-484) in the actual number of students retained or completed.
