

## ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD

### FALL 2002 ENROLLMENT SURVEY REPORT

Fall opening enrollment (E1) data for credit-generating students are recorded by the colleges at the end of the regular fall registration period, which is usually the 10th day. Historically, the census data have provided a "snapshot" of fall term enrollment for year-to-year and institution-to-institution comparisons and are used for comparison to fall enrollment data in postsecondary institutions nationwide. However, the diversities of the community college system and its students are not fully captured in these opening enrollment data. The expansion in module and late-starting classes along with the colleges' efforts to provide flexibility in scheduling from year to year increases the difficulty in reporting and comparing fall data. Enrollment trend data are best captured through the use of annual enrollment data.

Based on preliminary counts, there was a substantial increase in both headcount and FTE for fall 2002. The number of students enrolled in credit courses at community colleges as of the end of registration for fall term 2002 was 355,753, an increase of 16,751 students (+4.9%) from the fall term of 2001. The total fall 2002 FTE enrollment was 193,500, an increase of 10,477 (+5.7%) from 2001. Preliminary counts are based on the internet based Fall Enrollment Survey and are subject to verification upon receipt of fall enrollment (E1) data.

Table 1 contains comparative fall census enrollments for the last five years. This is the first year of notable headcount enrollment growth over the past five years. The growth in FTE enrollments over the last two years was preceded by three years of decrease.

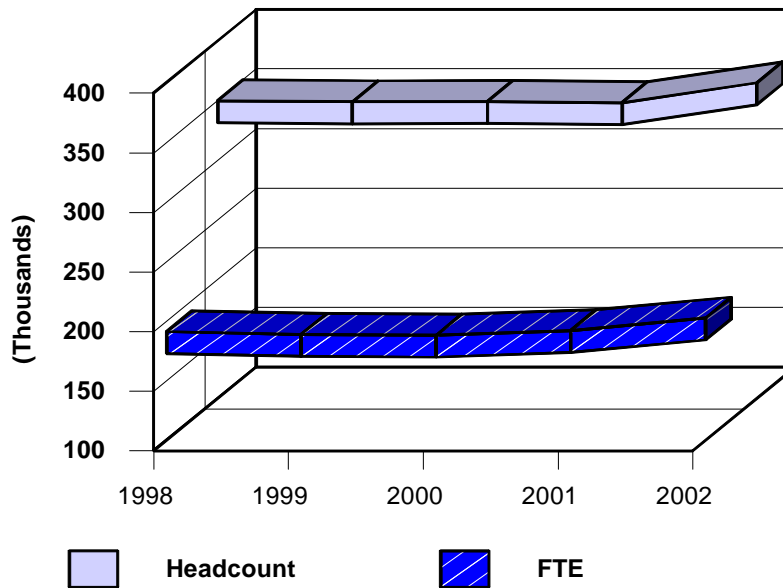


Figure 1. Opening Fall Headcount and FTE Enrollment, 1998-2002

Table 2 provides a comparison of fall 1998 through fall 2002 headcount enrollments for each community college. Of the 48 community colleges, 34 colleges experienced increases in headcount, and this includes double digit headcount increases for nearly 21 percent of the colleges. Seven colleges exhibited decreases during the past year, and an additional seven colleges experienced little or no change (less than one percent) over the last year. Table 3 contains a comparison of FTE enrollments for the five-year period. Over the past year, FTE increases were reported by 40 colleges, decreases by 4, and 4 colleges indicated little or no change. Likewise, double digit FTE increases were reported by nearly 21 percent of the colleges.

Table 4 provides a comparison of 2001 and 2002 fall headcount, for each community college, broken out into correctional and non-correctional enrollments. Table 5 shows a comparison of FTE enrollments, both correctional and non-correctional, for fall 2001 and fall 2002 at each community college.

Nine Illinois community colleges extended instructional services to correctional institutions in the fall semester of 2002, while 15 colleges did so in fall 2001. Correctional headcounts accounted for 0.8 percent of the statewide headcount and correctional FTE accounted for 0.7 percent of the overall FTE in fall 2002. These proportions are slightly lower than those reported for fall 2001.

An examination of only correctional enrollments reveals that headcount decreased 16.6 percent. Likewise, FTE decreased 15.6 percent at correctional institutions. Recent state budget cutbacks are a contributing factor to the decreases in correctional enrollments.

Headcount enrollments that were exclusively non-correctional increased 5.2 percent from fall 2001 to fall 2002, comparable to the overall headcount increase of 4.9 percent. The overall FTE increase of 5.7 percent was comparable to the increase of 5.9 percent in non-correctional FTE enrollment.
