Title III—Wagner Peyser [IDES]

Title III of WIOA is funded through the US Department of Labor and administered in Illinois by the Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES).

- Wagner Peyser is a core partner under WIOA and has a designated seat on the Local Workforce Innovation Board (LWIB).
- As a core partner Wagner Peyser will be a part of the integrated WIOA State Unified Plan.
- Wagner Peyser will offer the following services through the Comprehensive One-Stop Centers:
