COD	At time of Registration	<p>Students unable to pay in full must enroll in our convenient "Payment Plans". Students receiving financial aid (i.e., grants and loans) must enroll in the College's deferred payment plan. Direct links to these payment options are found in myACCESS.</p> <p>How does the Payment Plan work? The Payment Plan allows students to make installment payments instead of paying the balance in full at time of registration. The number of payments depends on when you sign up; the earlier you sign up, the more payments will be offered. The total balance due will be divided into equal installments.</p> <p>Is there a charge to sign up for the Payment Plan? Yes. The College offers two types of Payment Plans – an Active Payment Plan and a Deferred Payment Plan. If you are on the Active Payment Plan, the non-refundable set-up fee is \$25.00 per semester and must be paid when you enroll in the Payment Plan. If you are on the Deferred Payment Plan, you will be charged the \$25.00 set-up fee only if a payment is processed.</p>
Elgin CC	August 9th	<p>Payment Options: Online, In Person, By Mail or ECC payment plans keep money matters simple! There's no more convenient way to pay educational expenses and manage your budget. Payment plans are not loan programs. No interest or finance charges added. Instead, payments are automatic - set them and forget them. Harper is now processing checks electronically. Be aware there will be a \$25 fee for any declined checks. IVCC	2 wks. before the start of the semester (Wednesdays)	At IVCC, first payment due date is usually 2 weeks before the start of the semester and always on a Wednesday. This fall, it was Wednesday August 3 and classes started August 18. This norms out to be the first Wednesday in August. We are fairly proactive with calls and emails before the drop, but it takes a lot of man and woman hours to get it done.
JJC	July 13th	<p>Students must make payments by the due date. If payment is not made prior to the time Student Accounts and Payments closes on the due date then any unpaid classes will be removed from the student's schedule.</p> <p>Methods of payment Online: at http://eresources.jjc.edu (Visa, MasterCard or Discover). KCC	First Friday of August	<p>KCC's first payment for fall is typically due the first Friday of August. We lose approximately 300 students when we deregister students for non-payment, but we recover about 65%. From a Student Services and an Enrollment Management perspective, this process seems counter intuitive. We are servicing the dropped students who return twice for the registration process each semester and we're losing enrollments after the EM group heavily invests in the recruitment process. We are also considering payment at time of registration.</p>
Lake Land	October 14	<p>At Lake Land, our first payment is not due until mid-term of the semester so our payment due date for this semester is October 14. FYI - You may remember from previous surveys that we do not cancel for non-payment at the beginning of the semester. We have not discussed changing to "at the time of registration".</p>
LEWIS AND CLARK	AUGUST 9	
Lincoln Land	July 6	<p>We had a work team that explored tuition due dates a couple of years ago. We wanted to move to a "due at time of registration" process, but we weren't comfortable with the technology available in Colleague to make this happen. If you don't use the auto-dereg process, it becomes very manual which requires the necessary personnel to make it happen. Our concern was that we start registration in April and then we have a manual process every single day until mid/late August to drop students daily for non-pay. We did change our due date to earlier in July to give us more time to recover enrollments after the drop.</p>

Morton	At time of Registration	<p>Tuition and fee payments may be made in the Cashier's Office or online. The Cashier's Office accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover, personal check, or cash. Tuition and fees are payable in U.S. currency on dates designated by the College.</p> <p>Students failing to meet published payment deadlines may be dropped from courses.</p> <p>Nelnet/FACTS Payment Plan A deferred payment plan is available through Nelnet/FACTS. To qualify for a FACTS/Nelnet Payment Plan, total tuition and fees must exceed \$100.</p> <p>Registered students who fail to pay their complete tuition and fees by the tuition due dates may have their registration cancelled unless they have signed a FACTS/Nelnet Payment Plan Agreement (See the appropriate Course Schedule for each semester to obtain exact payment due dates).</p>

PARKLAND	2 DROP DATES BEFORE START OF SEMESTER	<p>Parkland does 2 drop dates before every fall semester. These dates are always on a Tuesday. The first is 3 weeks before the start of classes and the second is 1 week before the start of classes. So this Fall we started on August 22nd and did drops on August 2nd and August 16th. We are currently discussing this process for possible change also. We repeat this process in the spring as well.</p>

Waubonsee	At time of Registration	<p>Waubonsee requires that a full or partial payment be made at the time of registration, but we offer a variety of payment options.</p> <p>Full Payment: Tuition and fees totaling less than \$200 require full payment. Partial Payment: Pay the required first installment and then pay the remaining balance in monthly installments. A nonrefundable payment plan fee applies to this option and is automatically added to your balance. A late payment fee will also be added to your balance for each payment not made by the due date. See fee schedule for fee amounts. Learn more about our payment plans and how early registration means smaller payments!</p> <p>Employer Payments: If your employer is paying your tuition and fees, and should be billed directly, a letter from your company, including the contact name and company address (on company letterhead), is required at the time of registration.</p> <p>Non-Payment Waubonsee cancels registration if students do not select a payment option at the time of registration. Please note that payment is even required during college holidays and breaks. Enrollment will NOT be cancelled if any payment has been received for the semester.</p> <p>Students withdrawn for non-payment after the first day of class must petition to re-</p>

		<p>enroll in that course. A re-enrollment fee plus a minimum of one-half of the tuition is due when re-registering.</p> <p>You must officially withdraw from each course you do not plan to attend. Unpaid fees will prevent registration for additional courses or receipt of grades, and are subject to the collection procedures of the college.</p>
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
