Black Hawk College	We have had some success with advising the teams in groups since they often like to take classes together and are typically transferring to an unknown 4 year institution.
Carl Sandburg College	We do attendance and academic checks on at least a monthly basis and mandate study tables for those who are receiving any grade lower than a C. The study table is a real pain to administer, but it has greatly increased the academic achievement of many athletes.
Elgin Community College	We have a well-developed Athletes Commit to Education (ACE) Program which is connected to our Retention Alert (datatel module) and provides an early alert to the Athletic Director if athletes are not attending class or are experiencing academic difficulty. Additionally, every athlete is REQUIRED to have an Education Plan developed with one of our Advisors.

Illinois Valley Community College	We do have an attendance tracker and academic progress report process that is coordinated by the Athletics Administrative Assistant and the Athletic Director that works on the retention aspect and has been very successful.
Joliet Junior College	
Kankakee Community College	Athletes receive advising services like every student on campus. They meet with an assigned advisor according to their academic program, i.e., health career, business, technology, transfer, etc. We do, however, assign one coach to assist our athletes with academic success programs.
Kaskaskia College	We have a retention specialist that works out of the Academic Advising department but, that position is working with students at-risk of dropping out. With a lack of academic advisors (3) we have gone to a group advising format for all athletic teams. The week of online registration we have all returning student-athletes and their coaches go through the process of getting enrolled for the upcoming term. We have done this for 2 years now and it is not perfect but, we save a lot of time when the students do not come individually. We have some additional adjustments that we are working on but, I believe that it has been a benefit for the players, coaches and advising staff.

Lincoln Land Community College	We have 5 full time Student Development Professionals. One of our SDPs has responsibility for working with student athletes, but she also works with other students as well. And, we have other SDPs that work with our nursing students and other Health Professions students. But, all of our SDPs are generalists and see other students as well.
Moraine Valley Community College	
Parkland College	Our men's basketball coach is a full-time employee with responsibility for academic monitoring of student athletes (Job title: Academic Monitor/Men's Basketball Coach), and he does a lot of advising. When we're doing orientation or ongoing advising for student athletes, we use some of our regular counselors and advisors in addition to this individual.
Rock Valley College	Sports coordinators work directly with athletes on a regular basis which includes basic advising. In addition, the Manager of Advising and Coordinator of Intercultural Student Services have partnered with Athletics to provide group academic advising sessions and college success workshops for athletes this past fall.
Sauk Valley Community College	We do not have counselors, mainly because they would be considered faculty according to the union contract. Instead, we have academic advisors with masters degrees. We have 4 full-time academic advisors and 1 part-time advisor. During athlete registration, two are assigned to the athletes. If no athletes are in the office, they will take a regular student. We do allow athletes and nursing students to register for classes one full week before our web registration begins (2 full weeks before walk-in registration).
